Year 4 Discovery Museum Visit

Year 4 will be visiting the Discovery Museum on Wednesday 26 April 2023. On the trip the children will take part in a Lightbulbs and Circuits workshop where they will learn about Joseph Swan and his amazing invention, the light bulb, explore circuits through games and experiments and take part in an invention challenge to test their new circuit skills. The learning experience will consolidate the children's understanding of their Summer 1 Science topic Can we control electricity?

We will leave at 9.30am and return by 3.00pm, travelling by Metro. Children must wear their full school uniform and have a waterproof jacket, water bottle (no glass), packed lunch and bag. Please remember not to include any products with nuts or any fizzy drinks in the packed lunch.

If your child is entitled to a free school meal and you would like the school to provide a packed lunch, please contact Mrs Phillips in the school office no later than Monday 27 March 2023.

We need 3 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office no later than 3pm on Wednesday 22 March. A short meeting will be held on the morning of the trip to discuss safety protocols, in line with our risk assessment. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.
