Late Arrivals

- Reason for lateness
- Continue

Please complete this information thoroughly. Late is not a sufficient reason for being late; we need to know what caused you to be running late.

Meat in School

A reminder that the meat served at lunchtimes is not Halal. There is always a vegetarian option available for Halal children.

Medication in School

The school is able to administer prescribed medications provided they need to be administered 4 times a day. The medication must have a label on from the pharmacy. Parents are required to complete a form available from the school office.
