SafetyWorks! Visit

Year 4 will be visiting SafetyWorks! on Friday 24 March 2023. Established and managed by Tyne and Wear Fire and Rescue Service, SafetyWorks! is an interactive safety centre based in Newcastle. It provides realistic, interactive educational experiences for young people and community groups to learn about the prevention of danger and how to live safely. The learning experience will consolidate the children's understanding of their Ten:Ten RSHE lessons. We ask for a voluntary contribution of £5 towards the cost of the transport which will be payable via Parentpay.

Children will have an early lunch and we will leave school at 12.15pm and return for normal home time at 3.20pm, travelling by coach. Children must wear their full school uniform and have a waterproof jacket and water bottle (no glass).

We need 3 parent volunteers to accompany us on this trip. If you are available to help, I would be grateful if you could contact the school office **no later than 3pm on Friday 3 March**. A short meeting will be held ahead of the coach journey to discuss safety protocols, in line with our risk assessment. If we are over-subscribed for volunteers, names will be drawn out of a hat to allow the process to be fair for all interested parties.
