### **Reception Baseline Assessment**

The Reception Baseline Assessment (RBA) is a statutory assessment that was introduced in September 2021. It provides a snapshot of where pupils are when they arrive at school. It will provide a starting point to measure the progress schools make with their pupils between reception and the end of primary school.

The RBA is a short, practical and interactive assessment of pupils' early mathematics, literacy, communication and language skills. The RBA is not about judging or labelling your child or putting them under any pressure. Your child cannot 'pass' or 'fail' the assessment. You do not need to do anything. Your child is unlikely to even know that they are being assessed when they are completing the tasks.
