Great North Museum: Hancock

Year 3 will be visiting Great North Museum: Hancock on Wednesday 12 October **2022**. On the trip the children will take part in a Prehistory workshop where they will investigate artefacts to discover facts about the Stone Age to Iron Age. The learning experience will consolidate the children's understanding of their current Humanities topic, How did Britain change from Stone Age to Iron Age?

There is a voluntary contribution of £3 per child, payable on ParentPay, to cover the cost of the workshop and transport.

We will leave at 9.30am and return by 2.45pm, travelling by Metro. Children must wear their full school uniform and have a waterproof jacket, water bottle (no glass), packed lunch and bag. Please remember not to include any products with nuts or any fizzy drinks in the packed lunch.
