Keeping Children Safe Online in School

We use Netsweeper in school to filter content. This is an advanced content filtering platform that allows schools to monitor, block and report harmful online content across multiple devices. It is a hybrid solution that covers URL, dynamic content and crowdsourcing filters, all of which protect against a range of threats.

House Captains

Last week, all of the children voted for the school House Captains. Each child was given a vote and all children are made aware of the democratic process. Well done to everyone in Year 6 who put themselves forward. The speeches were very inspiring and we will find out who has been elected tomorrow.

That History Bloke

We are a Rights Respecting School. Last Summer we achieved the Rights Aware silver accreditation. We hope to continue our journey and work towards gold accreditation, where the rights will be fully embedded in our curriculum and culture.

Attendance and Punctuality

Thank you for adjusting to the new times of the school day. School officially starts at 8.50am and ends at 3.20pm.

We do encourage children to arrive from 8.40am so they can prepare for the school day, go to the toilet, unpack their bag and read with the teacher.

It can be very disruptive for your child and the rest of the class, if your child arrives late.

It is well known that a child who attends school regularly is more likely to perform better, is more likely to establish good friendships and is more likely to fulfil their true potential. We understand that children are unwell and when they are poorly they should not be in school. If your child is unwell, please inform the school office. If we have not had contact by lunchtime, our safeguarding procedures are then followed.

Authorised leave from school will only be granted in exceptional circumstances and is rare. Holidays will not be authorised in term time.

Mrs Bertenshaw leads on attendance and you can contact her via the school office if you require any support.

Extracurricular Activities

Please refer to the school website for information regarding clubs and activities outside of school. We do try and make these as accessible as possible for all our families.

If your child is in receipt of free school meals and you would like your child to attend a club, we can offer some support with this. Please contact the school office for further information.

Health and Safety

Only the school dog (who we have risk assessments in place for) is permitted on the school grounds. No other dogs should enter the playground, school or school field.
